

**COUNTRY: INDONESIA**  
**Indonesia Endowment Fund for Education (LPDP)**

LPDP will participate in the 6<sup>th</sup> Innovation call with the thematic area of Digital Health (Incl. Infectious Disease) and Bioeconomy (Incl. Application of ICT Based Technologies). Indonesian applicants are advised to check with its respective National Contact Point for who is eligible to apply and what costs are eligible to be funded before a consortium submits the complete application. It is advised that interested applicants visit the Call to get additional information including the guidelines on the Grants at the LPDP or DIPI website (as RISPRO's Partner)

**Eligibility**

Institutions eligible in submitting the proposal include:

- *Universities*
- *Public Research and Development Institutions*
- *Higher Education Institutes (Private Universities)*
- *Private sector / Non-Government Organization with R&D Capabilities*

Applicants eligible in submitting the proposal should:

- Indonesian *Principal Investigator* (PI) should hold the PhD or Doctoral degree and not in the on-going advance study, academic recharging or post-doctoral course.
- Indonesian PI has the international partner which is written in the cooperative agreement.
- Indonesian PI may submit only one proposal for one period (PI who does not have ongoing research project funded by RISPRO-KI)
- Indonesian PI should have at least 3 publications as 1<sup>st</sup> author or corresponding author in the international journal with minimum Q2 Scopus Index that relevant with the topic of proposed research proposal

The research proposal will be evaluated based on the existing review mechanism of the RISPRO's Partner that agreed by LPDP. Accepted and approved proposal will receive funding under the RISPRO-KI scheme (LPDP).

**Funding modalities**

The RISPRO-KI of LPDP will fund research proposal based on the Indonesia Government standard or approved institution standard or LPDP's standard. A maximum total amount of 375.000 Euro is allocated per project (3 years). The grant may cover partial or full cost of the project, both direct and indirect cost as follows:

- **Direct Cost**  
Covers the expenses incurred by the implementing institution in executing the project with the total of 95% of the total project cost, such as:
  - i. **Direct Cost for Personnel (30% of total project cost)**  
Consist of salaries or stipend of Indonesian researchers.
  - ii. **Direct Cost for Non-Personnel**
    - Supplies, material, Consumables, or instrument cost
    - Rental equipment (purchasing, buying small equipment can be covered if its project related need is clearly demonstrated)
    - FGD/capacity building/training, survey, seminar, dissemination
    - Mobility expenses:
      - Local traveling



- Travel abroad (maximum 2 times in a year and maximum 250 million IDR or 15.750 Euro)
  - Scientific event or project meeting (salary / honorarium of field staffs, resource person, surveyor, observer, respondents, experts)
  - Registration fee for IPR, research permit, etc.
  - Registration fee for scientific publication
  - Photocopy, Printing and Binding
- Indirect Cost (5% from total cost)  
Cost used to cover:
  - the internal monitoring, administration cost, institutional cost, and
  - management fee for RISPRO's Partner (2.5%).

#### Additional national regulations:

- *Focus areas for Digital health: development of Bank Data, AI, IoT, AR/VR, Advance Robotic, 3D printing in modern digital technologies and services to enhance the efficiency of healthcare delivery and make medicines more personalized and precise.*
- *Focus areas for Bioeconomy: downstream research of life science / health including drug / kit development, advance material / nanotechnology, and marine bio diversity research and technology.*
- *Project cost should include taxes and other cost need in the execution of the project.*
- *Project cost cannot be used for purchasing land, operational car, building construction, guarantee or loan, social grant to community and other expenses that not related with the project achievement*
- *Final project cost based on final review by RISPRO's Partner and /or LPDP.*
- *Expected output are scientific excellence (at least 3 international publications in Q1 Scopus Index, patent / IPR, prototype / proof of technology and social engineering model).*

#### Submission

Beyond the submission of the proposal through the dedicated online tool (PT-OUTLINE), the Indonesian applicants are asked to submit also via <https://risprolpdp.kemenkeu.go.id/> and read through the guideline (Pedoman Rispro KI) which can be downloaded at the front page of <https://risprolpdp.kemenkeu.go.id/>
