Universiti Malaya (UM)

All applicants from the Universiti Malaya are required to read the Universiti Malaya call text carefully.

All Universiti Malaya applications must be vetted and endorsed by the Universiti before submission. All Universiti Malaya applicants are strongly recommended to read the call text posted on the UM Research website (www.umresearch.um.edu.my) with comprehensive information including submission methods.

Eligibility

1. Eligible thematic area:

The Universiti Malaya call is intended to support the following areas of research:

- a) Sustainable Food Production
- b) Climate Change: Resilience and Adaptation

2. Eligible applicant and organisation:

The lead applicant must be an academic, have a PhD degree and hold a permanent or fixed-term contract in the Universiti Malaya. The lead applicant is directly responsible for the preparation and management of the project and grant together with the co-applicant(s), not acting as an intermediary. Lead applicants are encouraged to include early career academic as a member in their proposals.

Co-applicants (if any) can be researchers from the other Malaysian Universities but funding will only be granted to members of the Universiti Malaya.

3. Funding:

The maximum amount per project is RM75,000.00 for a duration of maximum 36 months.

Funding modalities

For research projects funded by the Universiti Malaya, the funding is limited to:

1. Personnel costs

Stipend for one graduate student involve directly in the project up to 36 months.

2. Mobility / travel (flight, accommodation, visas, vaccinations, local transport, daily allowances etc.)

Only fieldwork expenses are covered, which include only the:

- (i) local transportation and
- (ii) accommodation (if required)

3. Equipment

Applicant's chosen research environment should have necessary equipment to complete the proposed research project. Only necessary small equipment, maintenance and repair are covered.

4. Research Materials and Consumables

Only materials and consumables that is directly related used to carry out the project will be covered.



5. *Workshops / meetings / conference*
Only workshops/ meetings/ conferences registration fee is covered and not more than RM5,000.00 throughout the project period.

6. *Publication fees*
Applicants can include the publication fees (page charges) in the budget following the rate below:
 - (i) *Quartile 1: Up to RM3,000.00*
 - (ii) *Quartile 2: Up to RM2,000.00*

Submission

Applicants will be asked to hand in an official application through the easy online webtool and a copy to the Centre for Research Grant Management, IPPP Universiti Malaya. Please refer to the detail call text posted on the UM Research website (www.umresearch.um.edu.my).
